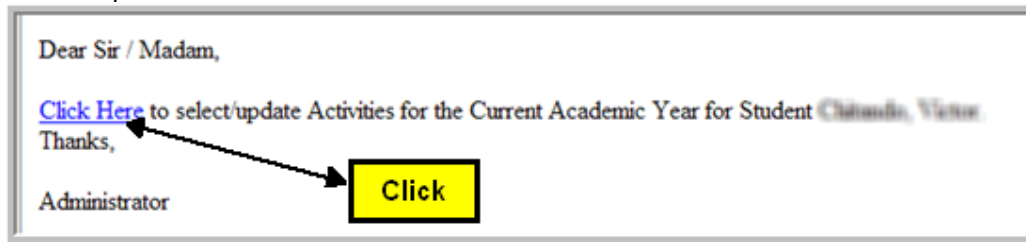




## Co-Curriculum Student Guide

1. This shows the amount of Activities you can select;
  - Compulsory activities are pre selected
2. If you have groups of activities you can only select one from each group.
3. If you see a link then the linked Activity must also be selected;
  - You will see the name of the linked Activity
4. Any blank can be selected.
5. A lock depicts a compulsory activity.
6. Click the drop down list and select a status for the activity., this can be in your order of preference but compulsory activities are always high priority.

Once you have finished with your selection you must save the information.
